Director's Statement

What would you do if somebody showed you the essence of life?

I was sitting on the sofa, my beloved companion Kubko sleeping beside me, when the story of this film began. He was taking a nap after a long walk, he was full after a meal, satisfied after our game with his toys. He was asleep and life was good. I thought to myself at that moment: Isn't that it? Yes. This is it. This moment clearly proves that life is meaningful. It's such a simple answer to what seems to be a very complicated question. At that moment, the only things we had were the present and each other. And that was enough. It is such a precious thing that we often forget that we truly own.

Kubko showed me how to live to the fullest, he was my fifth element - symbolising the unconditional, honest, simple and strong love and a meaning I've been searching for all my life. He showed me what it was like to feel at home on this strange planet. And I know you all carry someone so special, like Kubko is to me, in your hearts.

I have lost my dearest friend to cancer, something that is unimaginable to me to this day. But I know that he will always be with me, in my heart, in my beautiful memories I carry, and our film is definitely not about dying - quite opposite - it's about living to the fullest despite all odds. Which Kubko proved and showed me every second.

This is more a statement of love than a director's statement. I agree. Anyway, I urge you to live your life with those you love and hopefully our story is gonna be a reminder of not wasting your precious time.
